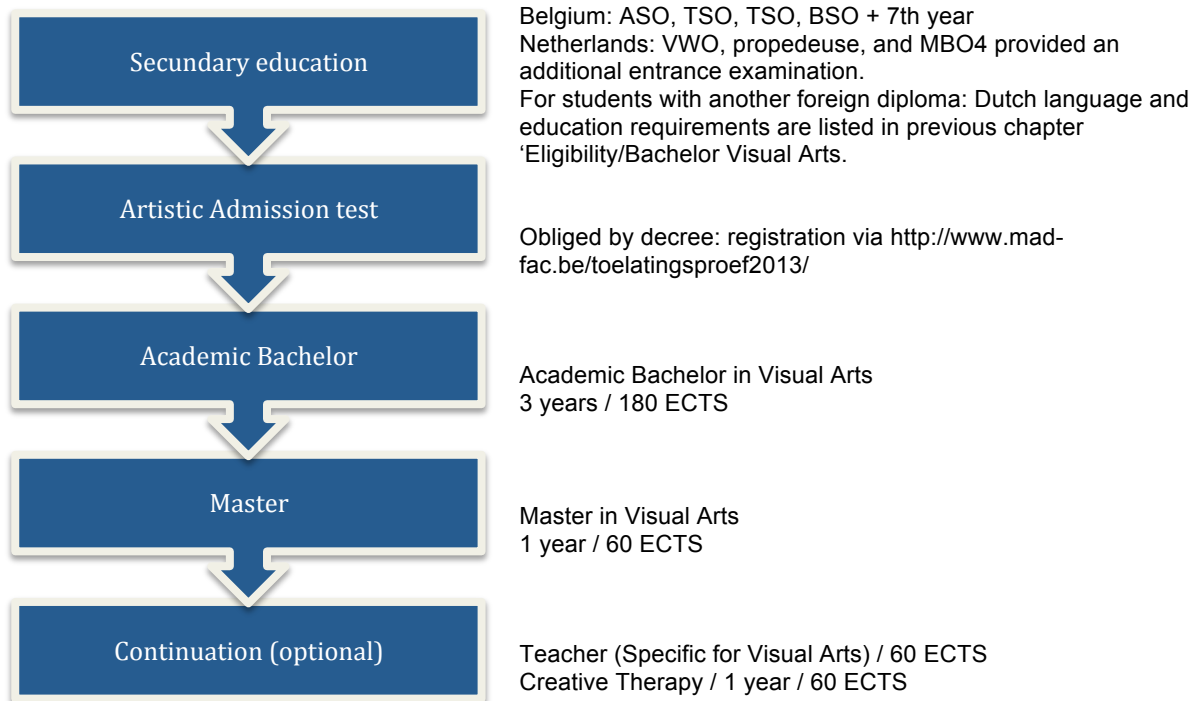


SCHEMATIC / INFLOW OPPORTUNITIES

1. You are in possession of a diploma of secondary education> 'Regular inflow'

With a diploma of secondary education delivered by the Flemish Government any form of higher education can start. For Visual Arts you have to pass an Artistic Admission test.



2. You are in possession of an academic bachelor's degree in a Visual Art related discipline (at least 180 ECTS)> 'Preparatory program'

You can enroll in a preparatory program when you already have an academic bachelor degree in, either:

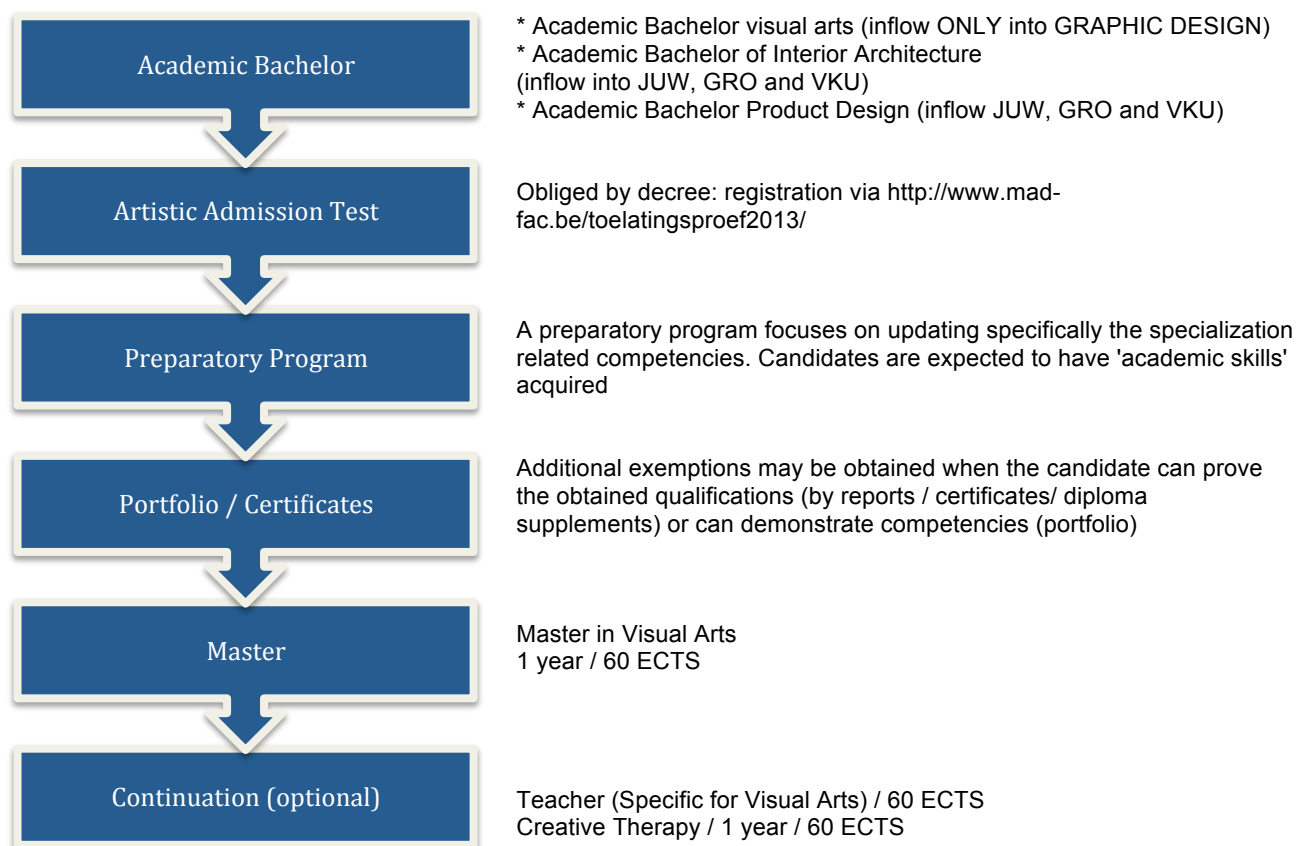
- * Academic Bachelor of Audio Visual Arts (inflow ONLY possible into Graphic Design)
- * Academic Bachelor of Interior Architecture or Architecture (inflow into Graphic Design, Object and Jewellery Design or Fine Arts)
- * Academic Bachelor Product Design (inflow into Graphic Design, Object and Jewellery Design or Fine Arts)

Candidates who enter through a preparatory program, already acquired academic, visual and/or design skills in a previous study and only have to work on competencies which are focused on the selected specialization: a major in Visual Art (Graphic Design, Object and Jewellery Design or Fine Arts (Printmaking, Sculpture, Painting, Ceramics)

'Academic skills' are practiced in parts as research skills, critical analysis, reporting, writing a paper and have to be demonstrated by diploma supplements for at least 15 ECTS

A preparatory program may be spread over two consecutive years due to the sequence of components.



3. You are in possession of a professional Bachelor degree in visual arts (at least 180 ECTS)> 'Bridging'

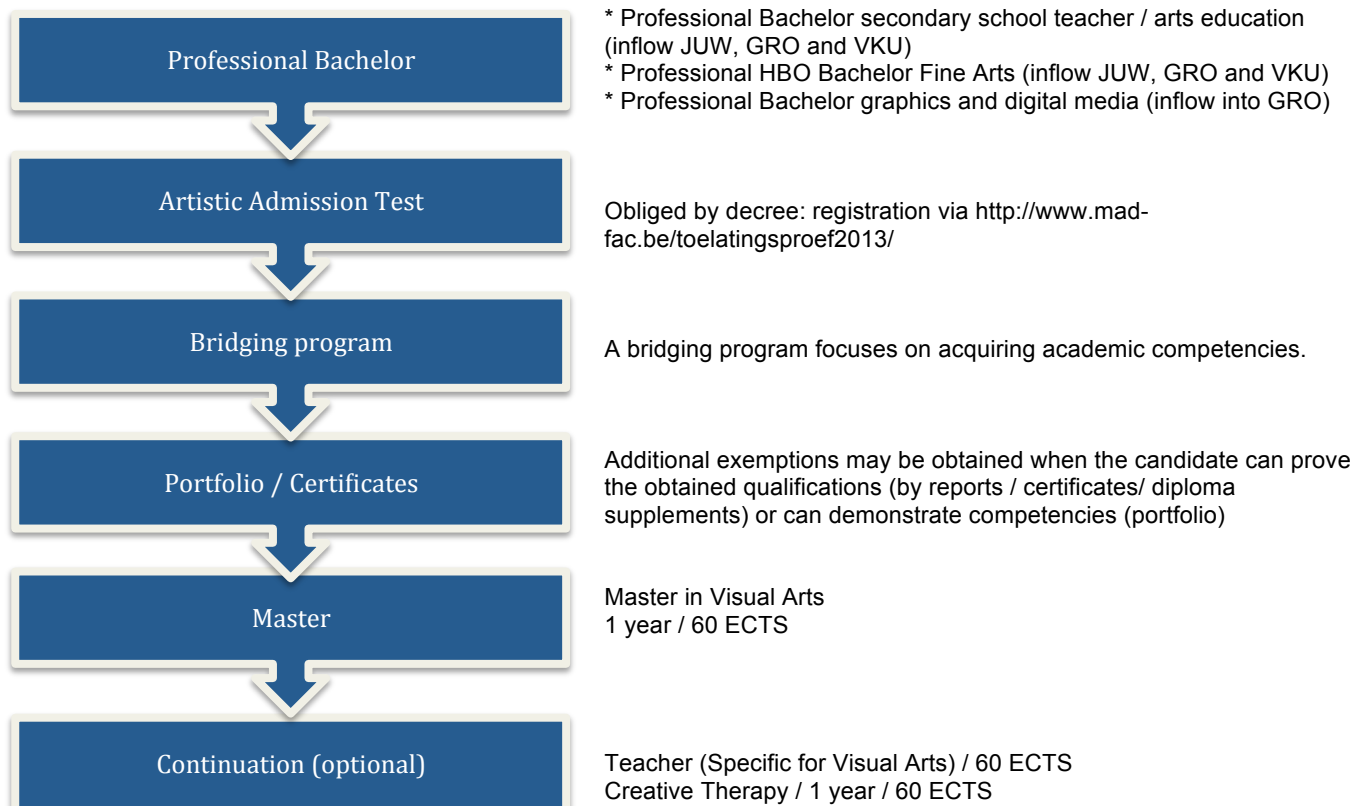
You can enroll via a bridging program when you already have a professional bachelor degree in visual arts, i.e. : ,
* Professional Bachelor secondary school teacher / arts education inflow into Graphic Design, Object and Jewellery Design or Fine Arts)

* Higher Professional Education in Fine Arts inflow into Graphic Design, Object and Jewellery Design or Fine Arts)

* Professional Bachelor graphics and digital media (inflow ONLY possible into Graphic Design)

Candidates, who enter through a bridging program, already acquired visual or artistic competences in a previous study (demonstrated by diploma supplements) and only have to work on their academic skills. Academic skills are practiced in areas such as research skills, critical analysis, reporting, writing a paper.

A preparatory program may be spread over two consecutive years due to the sequence of components,...



4. You are in possession of a Bachelor's degree other than those mentioned previously> inflow in the first year with possible exemptions

Do you already have a bachelor degree, but it is not sufficient to flow through a preparatory or bridging program, then you can eventually enroll after you passed an Artistic Admission test. On the basis of previously acquired qualifications it is possible to obtain additional exemptions.
