Master in Visual Arts (English programme – English & Regular programme – Dutch) 2016-2017

Registration/Application

Procedure

If you want to enroll in our English or Regular Master Programme, you must register your application online by completing the digital application form and upload the requested supporting documents (1). When your application is accepted (2) you can enroll in the student office (3).

Step 1. Application

- Complete the Master's application form

Requested documents

- A copy of your identity card, international passport or prove of registration in the register of foreigners.
 - A legalised copy of your Bachelor (Undergraduate) diploma, as well as a translation by a certified translator to Dutch, French, German or English.
 - Transcript of records of your previous studies (with detailed contents, study credits and scores per academic year and per course) If you are still preparing for an exam at the time of application, you need to send the final results as soon as they are available. We only accept documents translated into Dutch, French, German or English, provided this is not your native language. A legalised translation is not necessary.
 - A certificate that you obtained the required level of English language at level B1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR): TOEFL iBT (globale score minimum 57), IELTS (globale score minimum 4), certificate of a center for adult education (CVO) in Flanders (threshold B1) or other. If your diploma was awarded by an English university or if you are native English, this certificate should not be submitted.
- Upload your portfolio: a compilation (pdf) of maximum 20 images of representative artistic activities.

Step 2. Application deadlines

2nd September 2016

Deadline feedback (acceptance) from PXL-MAD, School of Arts

You will receive feedback from PXL-MAD, School of Arts within 14 working days. (Please bear in mind that our offices will be closed from 16th July till 15th August: applications from this period will receive feedback before 25th August.)

Step 3. Enrolment

When your application is accepted, you can finalize your enrolment. For this you need to make an appointment with the student affairs office: studievoortgang@pxl.be

Requested documents to enroll

- A legalised copy of your Bachelor (Undergraduate) diploma, as well as a translation by a certified translator to Dutch, French, German or English.
- A certificate that you obtained the required level of English language (see English language requirements for the English master programme)
- A copy of your identity card, international passport or prove of registration in the register of foreigners.
- A valid residence certificate.
- For students coming from China : an APS certificate (Akademische Prüfstelle – Certificate valid for studies in Belgium (Flemish Community)).
